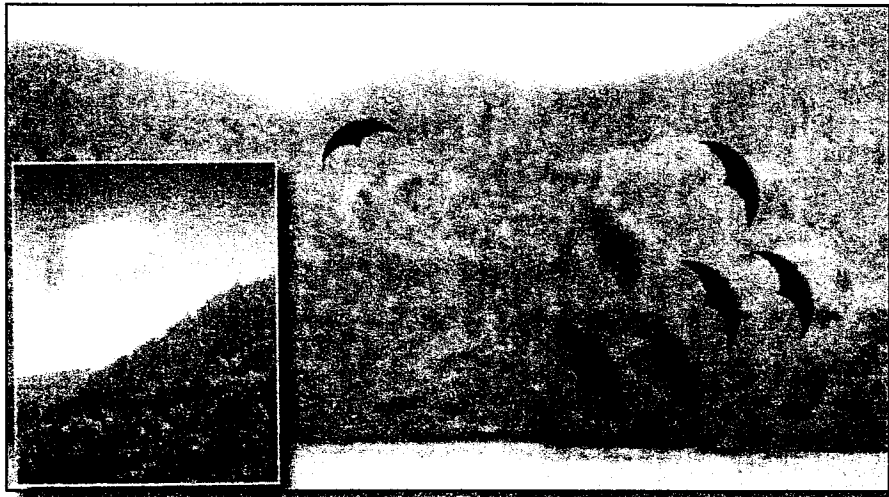


Are We Guided by an Invisible Hand?



The first article I submitted to FSR in Vol 48/3 Autumn 2003 described an identical formation of three boomerang UFOs seen in global locations, including London, Cape Town and North America. It was proposed that this identifiable formation of craft had toured the globe between late March and June 2001. Did these identical formations of UFOs trigger the most active observant responders among the witnesses to work and think globally rather than locally? Hannes Thiart from Cape Town who wrote the original article in the British UFO Magazine was one who did recognise the opportunity.

A recent case reported in UFO Norge returns to this theme of an identifiable known formation of craft. (The Norwegian Ufology journal is now published bound together with the Swedish journal UFO Aktuelt)

The case (illustrated here) describes four manta-ray UFOs passing over a fiord in Batnforden Norway, on 19th June 2009. The article further describes an oval craft with windows seen at the same time.

On Wednesday 8th September 2010, at around 3 o'clock a similar oval craft passed overhead in front of my car in Watford Hertfordshire. The four black manta objects circled over the town as they manoeuvred about one other. I hadn't opened the Norwegian Journal until the following day. More intriguingly the objects appeared during a very specific moment in my conversation which directed my attention to the potential of a Central European alien monitoring agency, European UFO Information if it were located in a neutral small central European country. I had been very familiar with this kind of UFO sighting which directs an observer's attention to a specific idea or objective. Are we seeing their simple attempt to use behaviourism in the shaping of our reason? Certainly it has been my impression that repeater sightings should be seen in their proper context, mirroring and shaping productive behaviours into the active responder witnesses. Very secretive and very personal UFO incursions from aliens who appear motivated to seek out and over-fly individuals repeatedly. My home was visited by a craft the morning after my first Garston UFO conference in 2009. The following report takes the personality of the alien seeking out the individual further, our very own Omega was overflown at the final Laughlin conference earlier this year.

Strange Object in the skies of Laughlin. *Omega*



Sunday 21st February 2010 was the beginning of the last International UFO Congress to be held in Laughlin, Nevada (USA) before it relocates to Arizona. At some point during the afternoon's lectures, I had the

feeling that I should go outside. A very strong southerly wind was raging - strong winds are quite normal in Laughlin. After gathering up some papers which the wind had whipped out of my hands, I managed to get my camera out to take pictures of the clouds. I had been sitting for maybe a minute at the most, when, to my left, a rather strange looking object came into view. The odd thing was that this unusual looking object was flying into the wind. To put things in perspective, I was facing west and there were two hotel buildings either side of me. The object came in from a northerly direction, dropped under the top level of the hotel block, then travelled in a straight line.

As soon as the black object was in front of me, it stopped, rotated, then carried on, still maintaining straight line, in the direction of the other building to my right hand side. The black object stopped again halfway behind the building then it was gone. Fortunately, during this aerial display, I managed to take a picture, hoping there was something of interest in the frame. The object was black, very black, with some kind of protrusions

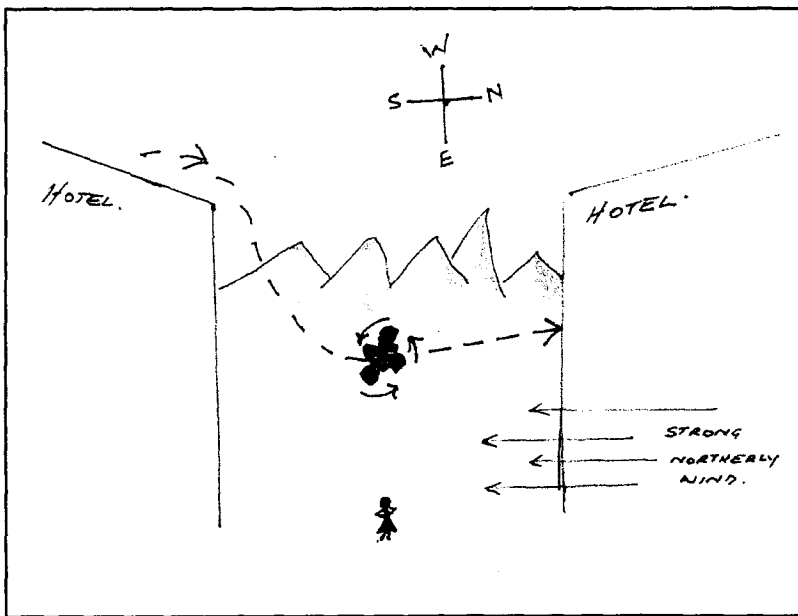
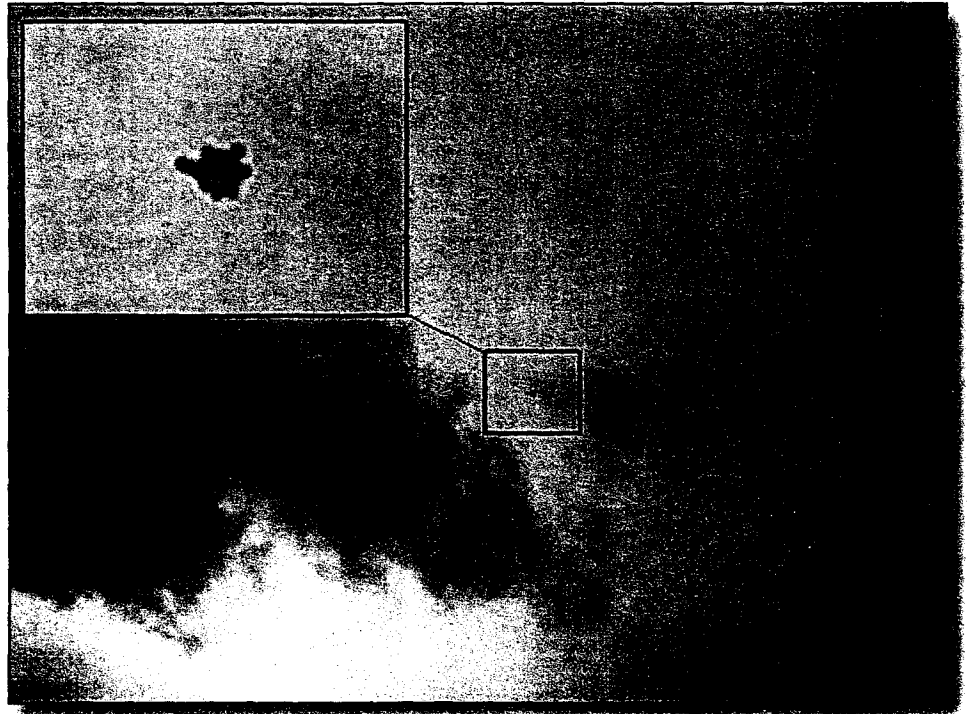
from the periphery. It seemed to morph, especially when it was rotating. One thing which surprised me was the fact that the object was much larger than it looked when reviewing it in the camera.

The only time I had ever seen anything like this object was during my very first visit to the UFO Congress, 13 years ago. It was the last day of the week-long Congress at River Palms Hotel. I remember looking through the window of my room, which was situated on the 8th floor of the Hotel. I had a clear view of Casino Drive, the main street of the city.

Suddenly I noticed a black, roundish object glide up the street in the direction of my hotel. It stopped, started again, went to the right and stopped again. I had a good view of the incident as I was looking down on the object, it was hovering that low. Finally the object stopped half way behind my hotel and the next one, for

maybe one or two seconds, and then it was gone. This particular object, although round, seemed to have protrusions around the edge. I couldn't quite make out what it could be. I was so astounded I could not take my eyes off the object, not even to get to my camera.

Later that evening, during the end-of-congress banquet, the organizer appeared on stage and said he had an announcement to make. Apparently a black, unknown object was seen by about 30 people who were sitting by the banks of the Colorado River, about 4 pm that afternoon. One of the Audio-Visual team managed to film it also. Unfortunately another person had unwittingly picked up the video and taped over the footage. Almost a lynching took place. As soon as I heard the news, I thought of the object I had seen during the afternoon. The time was a about 4 pm - this was the time of the sighting. I found my way to the witnesses and told them what I had seen. In hindsight maybe the object had come back to give me a chance to take a picture, even though it had been 13 years since I last saw it.



Comment by FSR: Omega's encounter with a matt black morphing object demonstrates the close proximity of cloaked objects around places of peak interest, the meeting places where intelligent discussion on alien life takes place.

At the very beginning of my UFO interest I was aware that UFO meetings were monitored by covert alien interests as much as by our home grown variety.

Last year I was reliably informed that, on occasion, human aliens themselves have historically appeared milling discretely in the audience at certain of these events. The problem with spotting the alien among us is that they are only readily recognisable to those who have already encountered them before. They will respond to a well put leading question accompanied by the right kind of discrete projected intention.
